



## Business Delegation to France For Environmental & Energy Solutions:

Building a low-carbon city with quality living through modern technology is becoming one of the major concerns of the HKSAR government. Hong Kong & Guangdong agreed to set up a liaison group in order to co-ordinate measures in **combating climate change**, including scientific research and technology development activities in relation to **clean energy, renewable energy** and new energy electric vehicles in the two places. Corporates, on the other hand, are putting more efforts into a **sustainable development** of the economic activities while imposing minimal damages to the environment and the ecology.

The French Chamber is organizing a delegation to France, inviting the participants from public and private sectors, to explore the new technologies and latest developments:

- ❖ **Pollutec Horizon** (29 Nov – 2 Dec): the global forum for ecotechnologies, energy performance and pollution treatment solutions offers the latest technological solutions against pollutions and resources optimization (industrial process, renewable energy, R&D, etc).
